

Student Senate Executive Meeting

Minutes

President Anna Dapper called meeting to order at 12:06pm.

Review of last meetings minutes. Vice President Darin Brigham moves to approve the minutes from the last meeting. Liz Smith (Treasurer) seconds.

Motion passes.

- II. Voter Registration Drive discussion. Volunteers are needed to help with the forums at the courthouse. The deadline to register is approaching fast so the tentative dates of the voter registration drive will be Thurs. Oct 14th, and Mon. Oct 18th of 2004. A table and space in the hall needs to be reserved.
- III. Discussion of shirts. Committee chair Kelly Nygaard (secretary) updated executive board on progress being made by committee.
- IV. Agenda for October 18th meeting. Secretary Kelly Nygaard suggests creating a spot in the agenda for student concerns. Darin Brigham (Vice President) would like five minutes at the next meeting to give a basic overview of what MSCSA is and what will be happening and the Fall MSCSA General Assembly. President Anna Dapper will give a brief report on the recent trip to Washington DC. The meal provided will be chicken.
- V. Advisor Dave Edwards goes over schedule and events of MSCSA. Each school is expected to bring a sweatshirt that will be put in the annual auction. Kelly Nygaard (Secretary) makes motion to approve a budget of \$50 to purchase a sweatshirt to be auctioned at the MSCSA fall GA. Darin Brigham (Vice President) seconds the motion.

- VI. Discussion of activities for year. Secretary Kelly Nygaard suggests helping the food drive by sponsoring a competition between the programs, the winner receiving a pizza party. Discussion takes place, and it is decided that the winner will be determined by weight per person in each program. Kelly Nygaard (Secretary) makes a motion to approve \$100 for the purchase of pizza for the winning program in the food drive competition. Treasurer Liz Smith seconds motion.

Darin Brigham (Vice president) suggests a pool tournament which he would like to have organized and started by the end of the month. He suggests getting a trophy for the winner which would remain in the building. Treasurer Liz Smith makes a motion for \$75 to be put towards the purchase of a trophy for the pool tournament. Kelly Nygaard (Secretary) seconds motion.
Motion passes.
Vice President Darin Brigham stresses the importance of forming a committee to organize the club awards night soon. Volunteers to be on the committee will be asked for at the next meeting.
The purchase of a gavel for the president is discussed. Vice President

Darin Brigham moves to approve the cost of a gavel for up to \$30. Treasurer
Liz Smith seconds motion.
